HISTORY OF THE CENTER FOR PSYCHOANALYTIC STUDIES

Training in psychoanalysis has been available in the Houston area since 1964. Until 1974 however, it was necessary for trainees to travel to New Orleans for most classes and some of their supervisory experience. Founded in 1974 as a geographical extension of the New Orleans Psychoanalytic Institute, the Houston-Galveston Psychoanalytic School embarked on a full curriculum in psychoanalysis. In May 1976, the school was granted approval by The American Psychoanalytic Association as a provisional institute. At the May 1979 annual meeting of The American Psychoanalytic Association the program was accorded full status as The Houston-Galveston Psychoanalytic Institute. In September 1994 the two-year adult psychotherapy training program was begun. In 1996, trainees in Austin began travelling to Houston for training. A child/adolescent psychodynamic psychotherapy training program was begun in September 1999. In 2011, the Houston-Galveston Psychoanalytic Institute changed its name to the Center for Psychoanalytic Studies. Today, with the increasing number of faculty in Austin, we are able to offer training opportunities through the Center without travel. The Center enjoys close working relationships with the departments of psychiatry of several medical schools- Baylor's Menninger Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences and the University of Texas Health Science Center in Galveston, Houston, Austin and San Antonio.
